

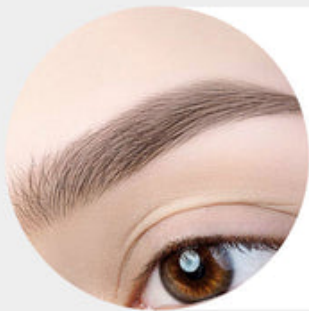

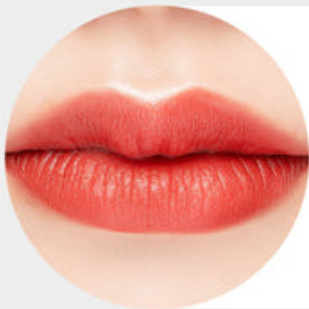

Ideal for delicate skin and low-saturation lines.



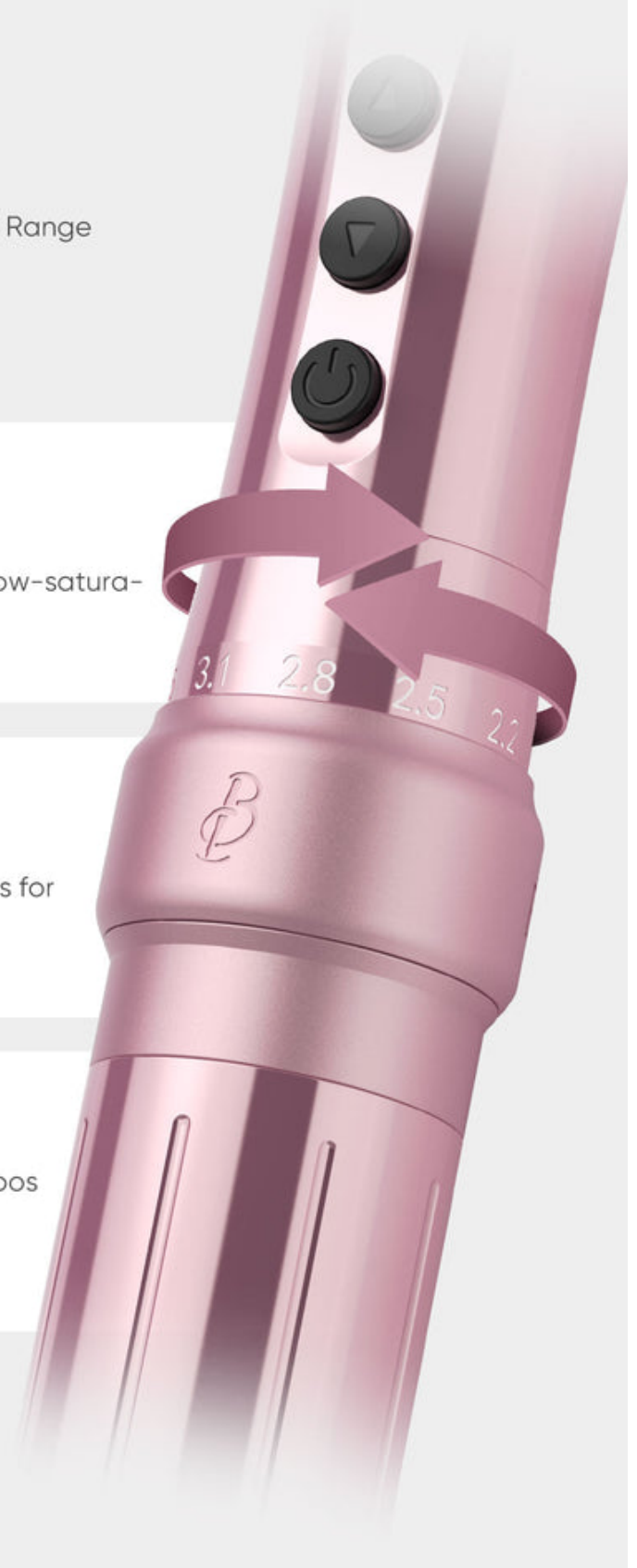
### 2.5mm-3.1mm:
