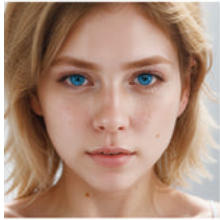

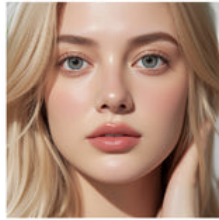

Light, Pale, White

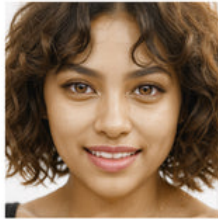
Always burns, never tans

Medium white to Olive

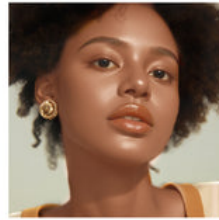
Sometimes mild burn, gradually tans to olive

Olive Tone

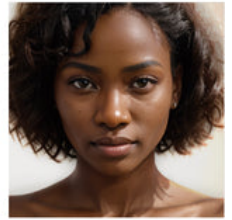
Rarely burns, tans with ease to moderate brown
