On interference engines, belt failure may cause valves and pistons to collide, potentially resulting in bent valves, damaged pistons, or extensive cylinder-head repairs.

Several factors can influence belt deterioration, including:

- High mileage and vehicle age
- Frequent short journeys
- Extreme temperatures
- Oil or coolant contamination
- Incorrect belt tension
- Worn tensioners or idler pulleys

Regular servicing can identify related problems before they develop into a major engine failure.



Timing Belt Replacement Intervals in the UK
